

Certified Application Counselor (CAC) Certification Requirements

The Benefits:

You and/or your staff will be able to help Connecticut residents with assessing their eligibility and facilitating their enrollment into Medicaid (HUSKY), the Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP), or Qualified Health Plans.



Access Health CT will certify participation in the CAC Program, if the following requirements are met:

- All participants in the Program must complete the online Certification Program and earn a passing score of at least 80% on the Examination.
- CACs and their sponsoring organizations must sign the Certified Application Counselor Program Policies & Agreement documents.

Organizations must fall into one of these categories:

- Federally Qualified Health Centers
- Hospitals
- Issuers
- Municipalities
- Healthcare Provider Organizations*

*(*especially Community Mental Health Centers and organizations on AHCT's list of Essential Community Providers)*
